FROM SACRAMENTO AIRPORT

Take I-5 South 5.8 miles
Merge onto I-80 W toward San Francisco 47.1 miles
Take CA-12 W/Jameson Canyon Rd 6.2 miles
Turn right onto I2 W / 29 4.0 miles
Turn left onto I2W/I2I 5.1 miles
Slight right onto Napa Rd 4.4 miles
Turn right onto Broadway to Sonoma Plaza 1.1 miles

Where else could California become its own country? Sonoma Plaza is a glittering microcosm of the West's colorful past —

from its days as a Mexican military outpost to its role as a Spanish Mission village and fleeting frontier republic. At one point or another, Miwok Indians, Spanish Missionaries, Mexican military generals, American adventurers, outlaws, farmers, fortune seekers and eccentrics all called Sonoma home.

Now a gorgeous historic landmark and “slow” culture capitol, Sonoma Plaza is a one-of-a-kind gem that radiates romance around every corner, cafe and cobblestone. This is where small-town authenticity, old-world ambience and cosmopolitan sophistication truly intertwine—a setting where horses graze near the artisan cheese shop, four-star chefs pick their own tomatoes and world-class winemakers picnic in the park.

Adding to the appeal is the fact that Sonoma was recently named one of the “friendliest” cities in America by Conde Nast Traveler. It's a destination that's as gracious as it is gorgeous. And Sonoma Plaza's pedestrian paradise isn't just friendly—it's family friendly, so ditch the car keys, grab the kids and discover Real Wine Country's historic heart on foot, bicycle or playground swing.

From its plush picnic spots and playgrounds to its vintage movie house, famous duck pond and old Depot Park railroad museum, Sonoma Plaza and its surrounding environs can fill a whole day with all-ages fun.

Whether you have a plan or you'd rather wander, the city's center makes for an ideal place to explore. The Plaza's old adobe storefronts, meandering alleyways, sunlit courtyards and historic landmarks hum with an eclectic mix of restaurants, hotels, tasting rooms, cafes, artisan boutiques and art galleries.

Anchoring it all is the tranquil Plaza itself, whose vast green stretches of lawn and immense tree canopy create a lush setting for cultural activities and festive weekly farmers markets.

What's more, a simple stroll just beyond the Plaza can take you past picturesque vineyards, rustic barns and horse stables, farm stands, a dog park and garden patches—all within a few city blocks. One of Sonoma's most beloved trails—the Overlook—departs a few blocks away, leading hikers through moss-draped forests, past glimmering creeks and the new Montini Preserve and on up to one of the Valley's most breathtaking vistas.

SONOMA'S BELOVED MISSION

REBECCA COSSELIN

THE HOME OF GENERAL VALLEJO

HISTORY

It's a time-worn treasure worth visiting on the northeast corner of Sonoma's Plaza—the Mission San Francisco Solano de Sonoma.

It was founded in 1823 and marked the northern end of "The King's Highway," El Camino Real. The Sonoma Mission was the dedicated goal of Padre Jose Altimira, who found his ideal location in Sonoma.

He blessed the site on July 4, 1823. The new mission was named San Francisco Solano in honor of the missionary to the Indians of Peru.

The padres' quarters, attached to the right of the present adobe church, is the oldest structure in Sonoma, dating back to approximately 1825.

The present adobe church was built by General Vallejo in 1840.

The historic Sonoma Mission is now part of the California State Parks System. This site is still in use today, offering historical and educational tours and hosting both public and private events and ceremonies.

General Mariano Vallejo's "Lachryma Montis" is a tribute to the indomitable spirit and adaptability of this remarkable man.

With the coming of American rule, the former Mexican commandante embraced a new way of life. He built this classic, Yankee-style, two-story Gothic as his permanent home in 1851.

Abundant springs on the hillside gave the place its name. The Indians called it

"Chiucuyem" after an ancient legend. Vallejo translated this into Latin, Lachryma Montis, meaning "Tears of the Mountain."

With a steep-pitched roof and dormer windows, the Vallejo home stands at the end of a long, lovely lane bordered by shade trees. It is a prefabricated structure, built of spruce and shipped around the Horn.

On July 7, 1933, Lachryma Montis became a state historical monument, open to the public.

SITE OF THE BEAR FLAG REVOLT

American settlers swarmed into California during the early 1840s,

but the Mexican government prohibited them from owning land or holding office. Tension mounted, and during the summer of 1846, a rag-tag band of Americans set out to change things.

Thirty rough-and-ready horsemen from the Sacramento Valley rode into Sonoma at dawn on June 14. They arrested General Vallejo and his men, hoisted a hastily made Bear Flag of the Republic at the northeast corner of the

Plaza and declared California an independent republic—all without firing a shot.

But the fledgling republic was to last only 25 days. On July 7, an American naval vessel captured the Mexican capital at Monterey and claimed all of California for the United States. The Bear Flag came down, and up went the Stars and Stripes. In 1911, the Bear Flag officially became the California State Flag. The monument to the Bear Flag Revolt can be found in the northeast quadrant of the Sonoma Plaza park.

JACK LONDON'S BEAUTY RANCH

Here at Jack London's beloved Beauty Ranch in Sonoma Valley, the famed author spent his final years.

His land became his passion. He loved exploring the Valley on horseback and, as he put it: "When I first came here, tired of cities and people, I settled down...on some of the most beautiful, primitive land to be found in California."

Today, 800 spectacular acres comprise the state historic park. Here you can hike,

picnic or bike among the trees; examine Jack London memorabilia and historic sites; or ride on horseback up a three-mile trail to the summit of Sonoma Mountain for a magnificent view.

London brought new fame to the region in *The Valley of the Moon* (1913), in which he perpetuated an Indian legend that claims Sonoma means "many moons."

The park is a continuing memorial to a remarkable author, farmer and adventurer.

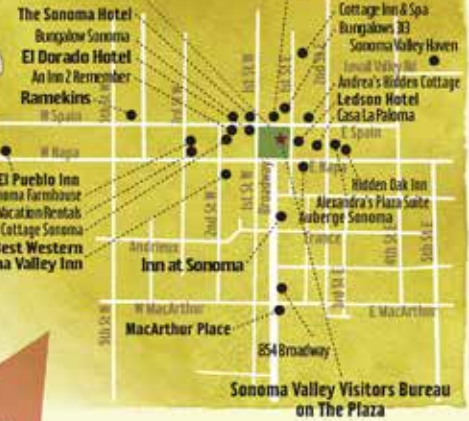

WINE TASTING 101

THE ART DEPT.

Learning how to taste wines can be as easy as 1, 2, 3 and will deepen your appreciation for the care given by the winemakers.


1) Look : Take a good look at the glass of wine. Tilt the glass and note the color of the wine against a white background. What color is it? Look for more than red, pink or white. Is the wine watery or dark, translucent or opaque, dull or brilliant, cloudy or clear?

2) Smell : Swirl your glass for 10 seconds and then take a quick whiff to gain a first impression. Now stick your nose inside the glass and take a deep inhale. What do you smell? Oak, berry, flowers, vanilla, citrus?

3) Taste : Start with a small sip and roll it around your mouth and across your tongue. Ideally alcohol content, tannin levels, acidity and residual sugar will be well-balanced and meld together. What initial impression does the wine make on your palate? Soft or firm, light or heavy, crisp or creamy, sweet or dry?

Next, what is the wine's actual taste on the palate? Do you note fruit, perhaps some spice, or maybe oak, cedar, or earthiness?

Finally, how does the wine finish? Can you taste the remnant of the wine on the back of your mouth and throat? Do you want another sip or was the wine too bitter at the end? What was your last flavor impression—fruit, butter, oak?

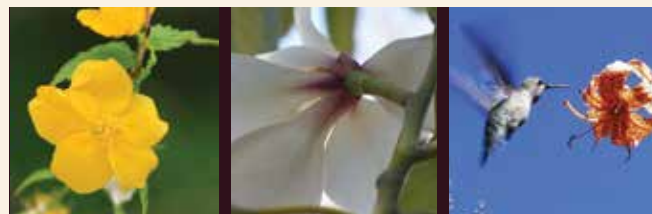

THE ART DEPT.

Sonoma's inspirational landscape nurtures much more than grapes: it feeds a vibrant arts scene both cosmopolitan and community-oriented.

A Community Treasure

Few places in the Valley wield the historic beauty, cultural purpose and resources of Sonoma's beloved Community Center. Founded in 1952, this grand dame of creative spirit and collective memory is an anchor to the arts: over the decades it has incubated countless actors, ushered ebullient parades throughout the streets of Sonoma, offered a cornucopia of classes and camps and provided the perfect backdrop to a wealth of homegrown local performances.

ARTS Fine arts abound across Sonoma's galleries, guilds, businesses and museums. Since its inception in 1999, the bold creative presence and cultural resonance of The Sonoma Valley Museum of Art has drawn over 130,000 visitors to more than 70 exhibitions. Just south of the Plaza, the museum's world-class fine art shows and interactive educational programs engage both visitors and locals alike. Sonoma Valley's verdant vistas play an annual muse to renowned painters when Sonoma Plein Air celebrates the centuries-old techniques of outdoor painting. For a week each year, nationally recognized plein air artists can be seen dotting the local landscape as they depict Sonoma in a dazzling palette of hues. There may be no better way to experience the bohemian edge of Sonoma's art scene than to stroll the avante-garde splendor at Cornerstone Gardens, where world-renowned landscape architects have created whimsical outdoor installations—
